

一前言

二安全使用注意事项

1.电源要求

设备支持壁装,安装效果如下图所示。






micro SD卡容量最大支持256G,插入micro SD卡后,不建议对其进行热插拔,首次使用时需格式化。



2.拧松螺钉取下存储卡上盖,插入micro SD卡。




3.拧紧螺钉固定存储卡上盖,将设备装饰盖上的箭头对准Logo位置,固定上盖。




安装步骤


- 1.安装面打孔。取出包装箱中的安装贴纸贴在安装面上。根据贴纸所示的打孔位置在墙面打孔,将 四颗膨胀螺栓完全塞入到安装孔中。
 - 【说明】如果在安装线缆时采用从安装墙面出线的方式,还需要在安装贴纸中间的出线孔位置打一个线缆出孔开口。




2.将设备固定在墙面。将设备支架上的四个螺丝固定孔对准安装面上的四个膨胀螺栓孔,将四颗自攻螺钉穿过支架拧紧到四个膨胀螺栓中,并锁紧,将设备固定在安装面上。



3.角度调整。设备固定在墙面后,参考本手册的尾线说明部分进行尾线连接,然后参考登录客户端部分登录Web客户端,根据客户端图像调整设备安装角度。



4.安装外罩。双手握住外罩,使外罩内侧的两个定位柱对准设备支架上的两个定位孔,推动外罩,由于磁铁的吸附作用,设备左侧、右侧、上侧支架将分别吸附在外罩内的左侧,右侧和上侧。 安装外罩时,根据需要将设备尾线从上方/下方出线孔穿出(掰开出线孔挡片,将尾线穿出)或从墙面出线孔穿出。



五 登录客户端

1.最低配置和系统环境

• 处理器: Intel酷睿i5 7500系列及以上或相同性能的其他处理器

• RAM内存: 8GB DDR4及以上

•操作系统: WindowsXP操作系统或更高版本

• 浏览器: 推荐使用IE内核浏览器, 使用其它内核浏览器会影响客户端部分功能的使用

• DirectX: 9.0c

2.设备激活

第一次使用时请运行IPCSearch,在IPCSearch中将显示设备的IP地址、网关等信息。若IPC设备所接入的网络有DHCP服务,DHCP服务器将自动给IPC分配IP地址。

- 批量激活:在IPCSearch中选中设备,点击批量处理,在弹出的界面中设置admin用户的密码和 找回密码时需要用的邮箱,点击激活按钮激活设备。设备将自动重启。
- 单个激活:在IPCSearch中选择设备,单击右键,选择设备激活。填写用户名、密码、找回密码时需要用到的邮箱。点击激活按钮激活设备。设备将自动重启。
- Web客户端激活:也可以通过Web客户端激活。将PC机与设备设为同一网段,登录Web界面。 可在界面设置管理员密码和密码恢复邮箱,点击激活。





3.修改设备IP

点击**修改网络参数**,在弹出的界面中配置网络参数。静态分配IP地址时,请选择自定义地址,填写以太网参数。修改参数配置,需要填写管理员用户用户名(admin)及激活设备时所设置的密码。完成IP配置后,设备将自动重启。

4.登录设备

1) 在IPCSearch中双击设备或点击**登录设备**,输入用户名和密码,登录Web客户端。




2) 弹出快速设置界面。点击**设备快速设置**,根据界面提示对设备参数进行快速设置,或直接关闭快速设置界面,进入浏览界面。



- 3) 登录成功后,下载并安装视频插件 (IE内核浏览器)。
- 4) 进入客户端后,直接浏览图像。

【说明】不同型号,浏览界面略有差异,请以实际界面为准。更多客户端说明请参考客户端帮助文档。

在Web客户端上,可以进行浏览、回放、图片管理、参数配置等操作。



附录A DC12V线径与传输距离关系表

IV Installation

The camera supports wall mount.

Do not peel off the protective film on the decorative cover of the camera during installation, and ensure the inside of the decorative cover is clean; otherwise, the dirt will affect image effect. Peel off the protective film after finishing installation.




Install Storage Card (Optional)

It supports max 256G micro SD card. After inserting micro SD card, hot-swapping of it is not recommended. During first use, format the SD card.


1. Pull the plastic sticker slightly and take off the decorative cover to expose the lid of storage card.



2. Loosen the screws and take off the lid of storage card, and then insert micro SD card.




3. Tighten the screws to fix the lid of storage card, and align the arrow on the decorative cover of the camera to the logo and then fix the lid.




Installation Steps

 Drill holes on the mounting surface. Take out the installation sticker from the packing and paste it on the mounting surface. Drill holes on the wall according to the indication on the sticker and insert the 4 expansion tubes fully into the holes.


[Note] If threading wires from the wall surface, it's necessary to drill a cable hole at the indicated position on the installation sticker.




2. Fix the camera onto the wall. Align the 4 screw holes on the bracket to the 4 expansion tubes on the mounting surface and insert 4 tapping screws through the bracket into the expansion tubes and make them tight. Fix the device onto the mounting surface.



3. Adjust the surveillance direction. After the device is fixed onto the wall, connect the buttcock lines according to the instructions in this guide and log into the web client to adjust the camera lens to a proper angle by viewing the image on the web client.



4. Install the housing. Hold onto the housing so that the 2 positioning studs inside the housing will align to the 2 positioning holes on the bracket. Push the housing and the left, the right and the top of the device will be adsorbed onto the left, the right and the top of the housing because of the magnetic irons. When installing the housing, thread the buttcock lines from the hole at the top or the bottom by request (move the block piece away to thread wires), or from the hole on the wall.




V. Login to Client

- 1. Minimum configurations and system requirements:
 - · Processor: Intel CORE®i5 7500 series or other equivalent processors
 - · RAM Memory: 8GB DDR4 or above
 - · Operating System: Windows XP or newer version
 - · Browser: suggest using IE Kernal browser, other Kernal browsers may affect some functions of the client
 - DirectX: 9.0c

2. Device Activation

When using the device for the first time, run IPCSearch in the attached CD: it will search devices in LAN automatically and display the list of device IP address, gateway and etc. If the network provides DHCP service, DHCP server will distribute an IP for the camera automatically.

- Batch: Select the device in IPCsearch and click "Batch processing". In the popup interface, set admin user
 password and the email address to find back the password. Click "Activate" and it will reboot automatically.
- Individual: Select the device from IPCSearch and right click to select "Activate". Fill admin user name and
 password and the e-mail address to find back the password. Click "Activate" and it will reboot automatically.
- Web client: The device can also be activated through the web client. Set PC and the device in the same network segment and login to the web. User can set admin password and password reset email on the interface and click "Activate".

3. Modify device IP address

Click "Modify Params" and set the network parameters. When configuring a static IP for the camera, please check "Custom device address (Close DHCP)" and fill the Ethernet parameters. During modification, the username (admin) and the password set during activation should be entered. After configuration, the camera will reboot automatically.

4. Login to the device

1) Double click the device in IPCSearch or click "Login". Enter username and password to login the web client.


2) An interface of quick setting pops up. Click "Quick Setting" and perform quick settings as the interface indicates, or close the window and go to live view interface directly.



- 3) After login successfully, download and install the plug-in (IE Kernal browser).
- 4) Re-login to the web client and view live video directly.

[Note]: Interfaces of different models may differ. Please subject it to the actual products. Please refer to the *Help* file for detailed explanation.

On the web client, you can view live video, playback records, manage snapshots or configure settings.



Appendix: DC12V Wire Diameter VS. Transmission Distance

The recommended max transmission distance when the wire diameter is certain and the DC12V voltage loss rate is less than 10%

(For DC12V powered devices, the maximum allowed voltage loss rate is 10%. All the wires in the following table are cooper wires, whose electrical resistivity is $\rho = 0.0175\Omega^* mm^2/m$)
