
2. 将安装贴纸贴在墙面并根据贴纸所示孔位打孔。安装贴纸如下图所示。




3. 将膨胀螺管插入孔内, 在上方的两个膨胀螺管上锁上自攻螺钉, 并预留5-10mm长度露在外。



4. 将设备背面的葫芦孔卡进螺钉并将螺钉拧紧,然后拧紧下方的两个螺钉,固定设备。







2.设备激活

第一次使用时请运行IPCSearch,在IPCSearch中将显示设备的IP地址、网关等信息。若IPC设备所接入的网络有DHCP服务,DHCP服务器将自动给IPC分配IP地址。

- 批量激活:在IPCSearch中选中设备,点击**批量处理**,在弹出的界面中设置admin用户的密码和找回密码时需要用的邮箱,点击**激活**按钮激活设备。待设备重启。
- 单个激活:在IPCSearch中选择设备,单击右键,选择设备激活。填写用户名、密码、找回密码时需要用到的邮箱。点击激活按钮激活设备。待设备重启。



● Web客户端激活:也可以通过Web客户端激活。将PC机与设备设为同一网段,登录Web界面。可在界面设置管理员密码和密码恢复邮箱,点击激活。



3.修改设备IP

点击**修改网络参数**,在弹出的界面中配置网络参数。静态分配IP地址时,请选择自定义地址,填写以太网参数。修改参数配置,需要填写管理员用户用户名(admin)及激活设备时所设置的密码。完成IP配置后,设备将自动重启,重启时间约为60秒。

4.登录设备





各参数说明如下表所示,根据实际场景需要讲行设置。

默认勾选,不能取消。人物标定矩形框为红色,用于框选被跟踪人物的 人物标定 只可设置一个人物标定。将需要标定的人物的上半身框在矩形框内,矩 度为人物的肩宽。人物标定区域不可大于追踪区域的大小。			

特写画面设置	默认开启。特写画面设置矩形框为紫色,用于框选教师特写画面的宽度,只可 设置一个特写画面。特写画面的宽度为人物肩宽的4倍到6倍。


1. Loosen screws at A, B, C and D and take down the cover.






Install the Device

1. Confirm installation position.




[Note] For common classroom, the suggested installation height is 2m-2.5m; for terrace or other kind of classrooms, the installation height should be adjusted according to the actual situation, following the principle of shooting the whole active area of the lecturer and allowing no angle between the blackboard and the edges of view.


2. Paste the installation sticker onto the wall and drill holes according to the hole marks on it, as shown below.




3. Insert the expansion screw tubes into the holes and lock tapping screws in the top 2 pipes, reserving 5-10mm outside.



 ${\bf 4. \ Clasp\ the\ back\ gourd\ holes\ into\ the\ screws\ and\ tighten\ the\ screws\ at\ the\ bottom\ to\ fix\ the\ camera.}$



5. Connect the buttcock lines up to request. Notes of the wires are introduced as follows.







- 6. Power on and adjust lens direction according to the surveillance image.
- Adjust horizontally:
 - ① Loosen lens adjust screw (horizontal)
 - ② Hold lens adjust panel to adjust the horizontal direction
 - ③ Tighten the screw
- · Adjust vertically:
 - ① Loosen lens adjust screw (vertical)
 - Hold lens adjust panel to adjust the vertical direction
 - ③ Tighten the screw



7. Lock the wires at the cable hole and tighten the fix screws on the cover and shut the cover.




V Login to the Web Client

2. Device Activation

When using the device for the first time, IPCSearch will display the device IP address, gateway and etc. If the network provides DHCP service, DHCP server will assign IP for the camera automatically.

- Batch: Select the device and click "Batch processing". In the popup interface, set admin user's password
 and the email address to find back the password. Click "Activate" and wait for rebooting.
- Individual: Select the device from IPCSearch and right click to select "Activate". Fill admin user name and
 password and the e-mail address to find back the password. Click "Activate" and wait for rebooting.
- Web client: the device can also be activated through the web client. Set PC and the device in the same network segment and login to the web. User can set admin password and password reset email on the interface and click "Activate".






3. Modify Device IP Address

Click "Modify Params" and set the network parameters. When configuring a static IP for the camera, please check "Custom device address (Close DHCP)" and fill the Ethernet parameter. During the modification, the user name (admin) and the password set before activation should be entered. After configuration, the camera will reboot automatically.

4. Login to the Device

1) Double click the device in IPCSearch or click "Login". Enter user name and password to login the web client.



- 2) After login, download and install the plug-in (IE Kernal browser).
- 3) Re-login to the web client and view live video directly.



VI Scene Configuration

Go to Settings > Camera > Scene and configure tracked area, retention time and sensitivity.



	Tracked Area	Checked by default and cannot be unchecked. It's in green rectangle which can be dragged to adjust the area. Only one tracked area can be set and only moving objects in the set area can be tracked. The area must be larger than the person calibration area.
		Optional, in gray rectangle, for defining the PPT size in the scene. Only one PPT area can be set and its borders should coincide with that of the PPT in the scene.
	Person Calibration	Checked by default and cannot be unchecked. It's in red rectangle for defining the size of the tracked person. Only one such area can be set. Circumscribe the upper part of the person into the rectangle, the width of which is that of the person's shoulder. The area must be smaller than the tracked area.

Close-up Image	Checked by default. It's in purple rectangle, for defining the width of the close-up image of the lecturer. Only one such area can be set. Its width is 4 to 6 times as that of the person's shoulder.
Platform	Checked by default and cannot be unchecked. It's in cyan rectangle, for defining the size of the platform in the scene. Only one such area can be set. Define the area according to the actual position of the platform.
Blackboard	Optional, in blue rectangle, for defining the size of the blackboard in the scene. Only one such area can be set. The area should be set in proportion of 16:9.
Aisle	Every aisle is made up of 2 yellow straight dotted lines, for setting aisle positions under the tracked area. The range of aisle number is 0~3 and by default 2. The top of the aisle is the position of the yellow dotted lines and the bottom of it is the bottom of the panoramic image.
Multi-Camera Mode	Checked by default. When the lecturer walks in or leaves the tracked area, switch to the panoramic image. When the lecturer stops in the tracked area, switch to the close shot and track the lecturer.
Vertical Mode	Checked by default. Allow the close-up image to center on the lecturer and track vertically. When it's unchecked, only allow the close-up image to center on the lecturer and track horizontally.
Retention Time It's the retention time of current tracking state, during which it will no tracking state. The range is 1~10s, by default 3s.	
Moving sensitivity of close-up image	To set the moving sensitivity of the lecturer in the close-up image. Drag the slide bar to adjust. The range is 0~10, by default 5.
Enable ePTZ	Checked by default. User can perform PTZ operations on Live View interface through ePTZ function.
Focus Mode	The same as that on the Image > Focus setting interface, focus mode including Manual, Single Focus, Continuous Focus and Camera Lock.
Default Layout Click the button to restore to the default layout and settings.	
Reset	Click the button to reset to the previous configuration.
Save	Click the button to save current configuration.

Appendix: DC12V Wire Diameter VS. Transmission Distance

The recommended max transmission distance when the wire diameter is certain and the DC12V voltage loss rate is less than 10%

(For DC12V powered devices, the maximum allowed voltage loss rate is 10%. All the wires in the following table are cooper wires, whose electrical resistivity is $\rho = 0.0175\Omega^* mm^2/m$)
